## List of Universities in New Zealand

New Zealand has a number of public universities that provide top-notch education. Some of the top-ranked public universities are as follows:

- **University of Auckland:** It is the top-ranking public university in New Zealand. It has a QS ranking of 81 in the world. It is situated in Auckland and the popular courses in this institute are business analytics, civil engineering, food science and technology, public health and nursing.
- **Victoria University of Wellington:** It is another public university in Kelburn, Wellington. Its QS ranking is 236. Its accounting and finance, development studies and social policy and administration courses are quite popular.
- **University of Canterbury:** One of the best universities located in Christchurch, it has a QS ranking of 284. Its data science, criminal justice, engineering and communication programs are quite popular.
- **Massey University:** It is situated in Palmerston with campuses in Albany and Wellington. It holds the 287th position in QS Rankings. It is known for its IT and software, aviation and medicine and healthcare programs.
- **University of Waikato:** It is a public research institute located in Hamilton. Ranking 331 in the QS world ranking, it offers 139 postgraduate and 109 undergraduate programs and also holds a 5 star rating by QS stars.

- **Lincoln University:** Situated in Lincoln, Lincoln University ranks quite high at 368 in the QS world rankings. Its B.Agri, B.Com and BBA courses are extremely popular among students.
- **Auckland University of Technology:** It is located in Auckland and has three campuses in the city. It holds a QS ranking of 486 in 2023. Its popular courses are architecture and built environment, communication studies, business, engineering, computer and mathematical sciences.

### Eligibility criteria for applying to universities in New Zealand

Clearing exams like IELTS and TOEFL is mandatory, and the documents are needed to prove English language proficiency. IELTS scores may vary for different universities; however, a minimum of 6.0 or above is preferred for bachelor's programs and 6.5 and above for master's programs.

You must have the required academic qualification from recognised universities. The percentage needed and other details will vary as per the university's requirements.

Although there is no minimum GPA or percentage requirement, applicants must have a high enough score to be eligible. For a professional master's program in New Zealand, relevant work experience could be required.

### Documents required:

These are the documents that you require to apply for university or college admissions in New Zealand:

- Completely filled university application form
- TOEFL/IELTS/PTE Exam Score copy
- Academic certificates for 10th, 12th and Bachelor's, if applicable
- Passport copy
- Job experience certificates, if applicable
- Other certificates of achievements in extracurricular activities
